





Science-based targets show companies and financial institutions how much and how quickly they need to reduce their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions to be compliant with the 1.5°C Paris Agreement target



#### What you have to do

#### Commit

 Submit a letter establishing your intent to set a science-based target

#### Develop

 Work on an emissions reduction target in line with the SBTi's criteria


#### Submit

- Present your target to the SBTi for official validation
- Communicate
  - Announce vour target a
  - Announce your target and inform your stakeholders
- Disclose
  - Report company-wide emissions and progress against targets on an annual basis

Commit to support us in Life-Cycle-Assessments with primary emission data


